DEVOTION - DEUTERONOMY 6



The Big Idea:

As God's people we are to be exclusively and totally devoted to God. The great fear is that God's people would turn to idolatry - therefore remember and obey (remembrance is demonstrated in obedience).

Our Growth Groups should be places where we remind each other to this end.

Have you ever been utterly devoted to a fad? Why did you keep going/why did you stop? Pictures: Agro, Backstreet Boys, tamagotchi, mullet, troll doll.

Just a fun into question to raise the idea of persistent devotion.

Read Deuteronomy 6

What is Moses urging the Israelites to do?
List as many instructions as you can find in the chapter.
Hear God's instructions and obey
Love the Lord
Fear the Lord only, serve him only etc.

What three big reasons are given for living in exclusive and total devotion to God? (v4-5, 14-15, 20-24) Divided these among your group.

4-5 That the Lord alone is Israel's God leads to the demand for their total and exclusive devotion to him.

14-15 Because God is jealous for his people's unqualified allegiance.

20-24 Because he has saved them - redeemed them out of Egypt, from slavery

Present these back to the group for discussion.

Just like the Israelites, we are to live in radical obedience to God. How does Titus 2:11-15 extend our reasons for doing so?

Redeemed by Jesus from wickedness to be a people for God (no longer just natural born Israel).

Why are Israel so strongly urged to not forget the Lord? What is Moses great fear for the people as they are about to head into the promised land?

v12, 6-9

Remembrance is demonstrated in obedience.

If they forget God's instructions they would inevitably fall into disobedient idolatry and face God's covenantal judgement v14-15.

They needed to obey God and the only way to do that was to keep reminding themselves of God's word.

How did this work out for Israel?

Is this our fear for one another?

How were they to remind themselves and each other? Draw icons or pictures of each activity.

v7-9 Teach them to their kids - fix them deeply into their minds
Talk about it any and every time, place and activity
On arms and heads, door frames and gates
v 20-24 Know the reasons God has given for obedience and remind each other of these

How would you explain this passage to someone who was about to join our Growth Group later this year?

This should summarise the study as well as highlight the significance of doing this intro study together at the start of the year.

To be growing in exclusive and total devotion to our magnificent saving God is what we want for each other this year.

From both Deuteronomy 6 and Titus 2 how can we be encouraging each other towards this?

What will that look like?

What won't that look like?

Finish in prayer for each other and your growth group for the year.
